



I heard someone say that we are a liturgical church, but I'm not sure what this means?

The word *liturgy*, comes from the Greek language and means *the work of the people*. It is the *stuff* that God's people all do when they gather to worship. It refers to the words and actions, the songs and symbols that comprise the worship of the whole people of God. If you worship on Sunday, and you aren't just attending a show; if you are actually participating - whatever you're doing is the "liturgy." It also means that the service of worship is done in a decent, orderly and logical way.


