WE AFFIRM THE FOLLOWING:

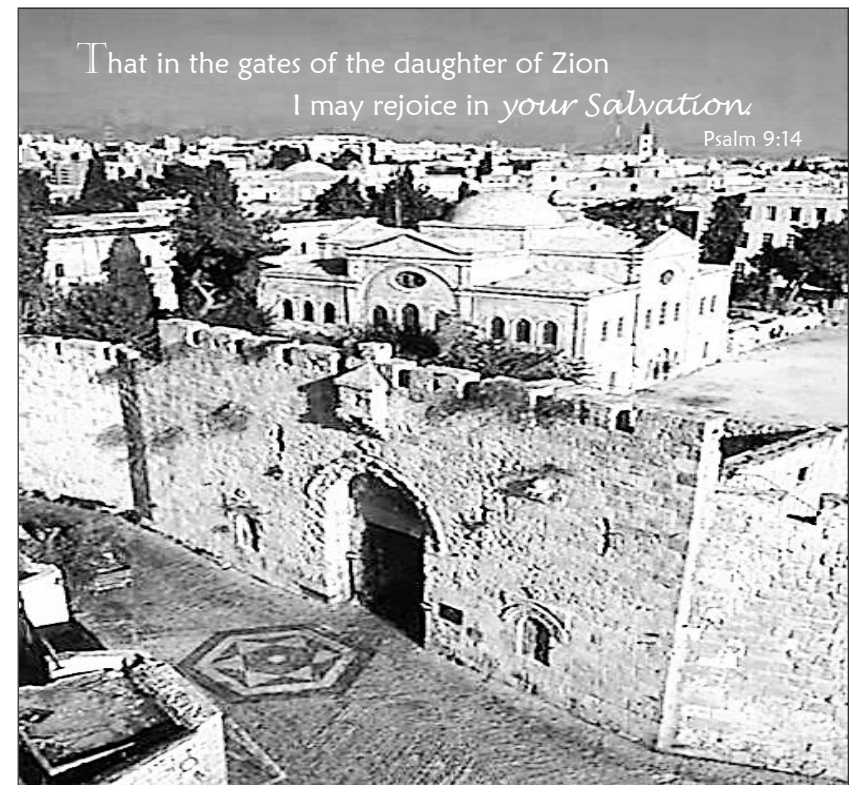
- The Holy Trinity of God - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

One of the items on display will be this early printing from the Gospel of John Chapter 2 as it appeared when 1st published in 1534 and reprinted in 1705. In addition to the text there is an original woodcut illustration of Jesus at Cana turning water into wine.



An important part of Martin Luther's reforms was recognizing that the Bible needed to be translated into the language of the people. During his time in Wartburg Castle, Luther began to translate the New Testament into German in order to make it more accessible to "all the people of the nation." ...and from there it became the Bible translation that "rocked the world," introduced mass media, unified a nation, and set the standard for all future biblical translations
