

- Coordinate with Church vendors and service providers (insurance agent, fire inspector, copy leasing company)



Their Mission is to provide Pasco County's most valuable resource - our school children - with the simplest things that most of our kids take for granted.




Each week they pack more than 1,100 backpacks with safe, non-perishable, and nutritious food to see needy children through the weekend when school meals are not available.
